EDUCATION & EXPERIENCE

Dr. Christina N. Fick, DAOM, MSTCM, MS.Ac., L.Ac., Dipl.Ac. (NCCAOM)

Christina has earned two Master's degrees in Chinese Medicine, and Acupuncture, from the Colorado School of Traditional Chinese Medicine in Denver, Colorado. One degree is in Chinese Acupuncture (2011), and the other is in Traditional Chinese Medicine (2012) which includes nutrition, exercise, herbology, and other advanced techniques. In 2015 Christina graduated with a Doctoral degree in Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine from Oregon College of Oriental Medicine in Portland, Oregon. This two year, the accredited degree focuses on western medicine, integrations, diagnostics, and advanced skills such as lab/scan readings, advanced therapeutic techniques. Only 1% of all American Acupuncturists hold this degree. Christina is certified in the state of Colorado to practice Injection Therapy (BioPuncture) through DORA and FDA approved list of injectables. Christina has interned in Nanjing, China in orthopedics, in Brooklyn, New York in Labor and Delivery, and in Urubamba, Peru in indigenous medicine. Prior to being a licensed acupuncturist, Christina interned for two years at a well-established acupuncture clinic in Denver, Colorado. She was an acupuncture assistant, front desk manager, and acupuncture intern. This clinic specializes in oncology, autoimmune conditions, and difficult cases. Christina is licensed both nationally through NCCAOM #150355 and through the state of Colorado (DORA) #1727. She has passed all four board exams as well as continuing education credits. None of her licenses or certifications have ever been revoked. She has never been under litigation and never faced a felony or misdemeanor.

Dr. Jill Zundevich, DACM, MSTCM, L.Ac., Dipl.Ac. (NCCAOM)

Jill is a Licensed Acupuncturist in Colorado. None of her licenses have ever been suspended or revoked. Jill Zundevich obtained her Master's of Science in Traditional Chinese Medicine in 2014 including an internship at Zhengjiiang University in Hang Zhou, China and earned a Doctorate of Acupuncture and Chinese Medicine in 2017 at the American College of Traditional Chinese Medicine, totaling 3,500 hours of post-graduate studies and over 1,000 hours of clinical training. She obtained her California Acupuncture License in 2014 and practiced in California for 4 years before moving to Denver. She is now a Diplomate in Acupuncture by the National Certification Commission for Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine (NCCAOM #156387) and licensed in the state of Colorado (#2354). Jill's trainings include acupuncture, herbal medicine, Tui Na massage, cupping, and moxibustion. She has extensive training in fertility, cosmetic acupuncture, and orthopedics. Her clinic complies with the rules and regulations set forth by the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment. Only single-use, disposable, factory-sterilized needles are used.

- >Medical Acupuncture Initial treatment \$140. Follow Up treatment: \$90
 - >Starter package (consultation plus three acupuncture treatments): \$290
 - >3 treatment course: \$249
 - >10 treatment course: \$790
- >Dry Needling: \$110 Initial treatment + exam. Follow Ups: \$60 or \$275 for 5 sessions
- >Acupuncture for kids under age 18: \$75
- >Cupping: \$40 (for 30 minutes)
- >Labor Induction: \$80 per treatment.
- >Injection therapy: \$25/injection or \$100 for 5 injections
- >Functional Medicine Consultation: \$120 (includes Pre and Post consult) *Does not include lab tests.
- >Cosmetic Acupuncture: \$680 for 8 sessions
 - Follow-ups for Cosmetic Acupuncture: \$90 per treatment

*If herbs or supplements are recommended, that cost is separate (not included in the treatment cost).
